Primary Purpose

The Director of Next Gen Ministries will lead and oversee Next Gen initiatives across all NewPointe campuses. Working with executive leaders, campus pastors, and Next Gen directors, the Director of Next Gen Ministries will create an environment where kids and students connect with coaches who guide them through this pivotal season of life. By casting vision, developing a team, and directing Next Gen programming, the Next Gen Director will inspire children and youth to follow Jesus and equip parents/families to be the spiritual leaders of the home.

Essential Functions/Key Result Areas (KRAs)

- Develop, protect, and champion the Next Gen Ministry culture by providing leadership and oversight to all aspects of NewPointe Kids and Student Ministry (birth age 18) and Armor Sports Ministry.
- Oversee selection/creation of curriculum, global and local programming, and provision of resources for families.
- Ensure consistency, continuity and high standards of curriculum, activities, and content delivery across all campuses.
- Establish, maintain, and promote a clear, strategic, and sequential Family Framework easily accessible to families via the church website.
- Develop and promote a culture of leadership reproduction for staff and volunteer coaches; continually and actively recruit, train, and retain high quality leaders and volunteers/coaches within the organization.
- Implement strategies to evaluate and upgrade ministry environments to ensure that they are efficient, effective, and deliver the desired outcomes.
- Partner and collaborate with Next Gen coordinator, campus pastors, executive leadership, and campus support staff to ensure proper staff oversight to accomplish Next Gen Ministry initiatives, programming, etc.
- Work closely with leadership to provide directional oversight to departmental budget and expenditures, and ensure alignment with vision, values, and ministry direction.
- Monitor, evaluate, and provide accountability to ministry practices at local levels through regular meetings, setting and monitoring goals and achievements, and providing performance management, training, and development for Next Gen staff.
- Oversee volunteer/coach recruiting, onboarding, training, and appreciation, providing resources and best
 practices for ministry leaders; work cooperatively with other departments within designed frameworks
 to ensure that all global communication, production, and equipment needs are secured for Next Gen.
